You should have received your appointment slot for next week's individual visits to school. Please be on time and wear a mask in the room please. You will be meeting your child's teacher in Mr Paton's office.

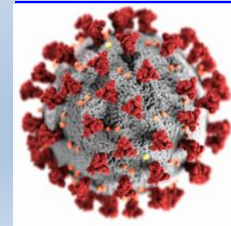
Where possible, we will arrange for your child to be with you in the meeting.
